



## Monthly 50/50 Raffle

Tickets for the raffle will cost \$2 each and are available to purchase from both ReStore locations (Nanaimo and Duncan).

ONE draw will take place on the last day of each month at the Nanaimo ReStore (Nanaimo and Duncan ticket sales will all be included in this draw)

Value of prize will be 50% of the total of all ticket sales.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

A total of 10,000 tickets are available at \$2 each with a maximum revenue of \$20,000.

Prize draws will take place on the last day of each month between 12.30 and 1.30pm at the Nanaimo ReStore, 1-4128 Mostar Road, Nanaimo, BC V9T 6C9.

Total jackpot for each monthly draw is dependent on the number of tickets sold. The winner will get half the total jackpot.

50/50 tickets must be purchased at either of the two ReStores: Nanaimo ReStore, 1-4128 Mostar Road, Nanaimo, V9T 6C9 or Duncan ReStore, 251 Government Street, Duncan, V9L 1A6.

### **Eligibility:**

Ticket purchase must be 19 years of age or older. If a minor's name appears on the ticket stub the prize shall be delivered to the minor's parent, legal guardian or trustee. A non-resident of British Columbia may purchase a ticket only if the entire payment transaction takes place while the person is in British Columbia and if the ticket or a receipt is issued at that time. Tickets will not be distributed to, mailed or otherwise sent to a non-residents third-party address in B.C.

Habitat for Humanity Mid-Vancouver Island employees, director and those persons responsible for the conduct and management of the ticket raffle, including employees of contracted gaming services providers are not permitted to purchase tickets.

### **Chances of Winning:**

There is to be a total of 10 draws (monthly from June 2019 – April 2020) at the Nanaimo ReStore location. Odds of winning depend on the number of tickets sold.

**Draw Dates:**

There will be a total of 10 draws during the licence period. Draws will be held at the Nanaimo ReStore location between 12.30 – 1.30pm on the last day of each month.

The winner does not have to be present to claim the prize.

Tickets may be purchased until 12.29 pm on the respective draw date.

In the event that a winning stub lists more than one name, the licensee will award the prize to any individual listed on the stub. The licensee (Habitat for Humanity Mid-Vancouver Island) is not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise between different individuals whose names are on the ticket stub.

Prizes must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions permitted. Winners have 1 year from the draw date to claim their prize. Unclaimed prizes will be donated to a beneficiary approved by the Gaming Branch.

Winners will be notified by phone and / or email within 10 days of each draw date. Winners consent to the release of their names and photo by the licensee. Habitat for Humanity Mid-Vancouver Island reserves the right to publish a list of winners.

To accept a prize the winners must provide the following:

- Signature on the prize acceptance sheet
- Winning ticket stub
- Copy of valid government issued identification

**Other Information:**

All sales are final. The licensee reserves discretionary right not to accept entries. Nanaimo and Duncan tickets will be placed together in one ticket box and the winning ticket will be drawn from that box.

Liability of Habitat for Humanity Mid-Vancouver Island shall be limited to ticket price paid.
