



FAQ

Q: How many hours do I need to commit to volunteering?

A: We ask that volunteers commit to 40 hours per year and a minimum of 2 hours per shift, but otherwise, the schedule is very flexible.

Q: Can I volunteer on the build site?

A: Due to COVID, we currently do not have any volunteer opportunities available at the build site. However, you can submit an application and we will keep it on file for future projects.
